You should be on the TRADE LOCAL database!

It's easy and free to get on the database... just complete the enclosed form and return it to the Trade Local team.

Once you join the TRADE LOCAL database...

Information about the products and services that your organisation supplies will be circulated to council officers who make those kind of purchases. Other local public sector organisations may also request and receive this information.

You will be informed of forthcoming opportunities to apply to join Council approved lists, and tender for contracts. You will be invited to procurement training and information sharing events.

One to one training and mentoring support, and assistance with trading on-line, will be offered to businesses based in targeted regeneration zones, who have been trading for 18 months or more.

TRADE LOCAL works with organisations based in Enfield and Haringey, free of charge.

About TRADE LOCAL

TRADE LOCAL is breaking down barriers between the public sector and local business, encouraging local trade and regeneration. It is financed by Haringey Council, Enfield Council, Middlesex University, Fit to Supply and the European Regional Development Fund.

Over the next two years, TRADE LOCAL will create innovative ways to share information about how the public sector buys its goods and services, equip local businesses with the skills and knowledge that they need to compete for contracts, and encourage the public sector to engage with local organisations.
